OLSP PARISH CENTRE (THE HALL) REPAIRS AND REDECORATION - AN UPDATE We have completed repairs to broken drains around the centre including the installation of additional inspection chambers. We are now awaiting the go-ahead from our Parish insurers, with whom we are pursuing a claim, to complete structural repairs and redecoration. With the insurers, we are keen to ensure that the settlement of foundations has ceased before permitting the necessary repairs and strengthening work, together with redecorating, to proceed. To satisfy insurer requirements, we continue to monitor the Parish Centre for any residual movement and hope to progress this to a conclusion over the next few months at which point all the work will be completed. Meanwhile, the parish centre is still available just to our Parish groups for meetings and assemblies; please always liaise beforehand with our bookings secretary Mrs Maribel Favor (maribelfavor@gmail.com).
