ST BERNARD'S ROOF

Following on from our presentation to the Parish AGM in Feb., we appointed project consultants and after an initial delay with the appointment of a Structural Engineer, he has now visited, noted the extensive cracking in the Church building and identified key parts of the structure for 'opening up' for further closer inspection..

Due to pressure on contractor availability across the construction industry, we have experienced further delay to the appointment of a suitable builder to carry out the 'breaking open' of the areas identified however, that appointment has now been made and the necessary interim work will take place in August, after the necessary testing for asbestos has been completed. The Structural Eng's., full report will follow and this will establish the full extent of the work required to the structure, including the defective roof. The Project will be developed based on those findings.

We currently have Diocesan approval to progress to tender stage and in order to continue to mitigate further likely delays, including establishing main contractor interest, we are progressing to agree a contractor tender list, ahead of receipt of the full structural report.

In the meantime and as explained to the Parish AGM, we have been advised that it is unsafe to walk on the roof and have provisional arrangements in place to attend to any leaks.
