FASTING AND ABSTINENCE – Fasting is a considerable reduction in food, abstinence is from flesh meat (or for vegetarians and other food group). Abstinence is mandatory for those aged 14 or over, fasting from the age of 18 to 60.

CONSULTATION ON ADMISSION ARRANGEMENTS FOR ST WILFRID'S CATHOLIC SCHOOL FOR 2025-26 ACADEMIC YEAR - Notice is hereby given in accordance with legislation that the governing body as the admission authority for St Wilfrid's Catholic School is formally consulting on its proposed admission arrangements for the school year 2025-26. As an admission authority, the school is required to consult the following:

- a. Parents of children between the ages of two and eighteen;
- b. Other persons in the 'relevant area' (set by the Local Authority) who in the opinion of the school have an interest in the proposed admissions (eg. local priests, other deanery Catholic schools etc.);
- c. All other admission authorities in the 'relevant area';
- d. The Local Authority;
- e. The Education Service of the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton;

The six week (minimum) consultation began on 11 January 2024 with the closing day for submitting comments being 22 February 2024. The proposed arrangements (admissions policy and Supplementary Information Form (SIF) can be viewed on the school website [here](#). Note: The 'relevant area' is the area for a school (determined by its LA and then reviewed every two years) within which the admission authority for that school must consult all other prescribed schools on its admissions arrangements.
