"DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION IN BOTH KINDS - Holy Communion under both kinds will re – commence at Our Lady & St. Peter on the designated Feast of Corpus Christi i.e. the Saturday 6.15p.m. Vigil Mass on 1st June and the 10.30 a.m. Sunday Mass on 2nd June 2024. It is the choice of the communicant to receive from the chalice, but the Church does encourage it. One Minister will assist the Celebrant in the distribution of the consecrated Host and two Ministers will be available to administer the Precious Blood; one on each side of the altar. The Minister offers the chalice and says "The Blood of Christ" and the communicant replies "Amen". There will be a re – commissioning of Ministers of Holy Communion at both Masses."

Procedure for online payments made direct to the Parish account now follows: The formal title of the Parish bank account with HSBC is 'A&B Diocesan Trust Registered Charity East Grinstead Our Lady & St Peter'. Parish sort code is 40-05-20, the Parish account number is 71076841. Some banks can be very precise over how much space is afforded for titles and abbreviating ours to suit is fine. However, the sort code and account numbers are the key elements. Again, if a transaction is made in connection with the Pledge Appeal, please ensure that its reference detail includes your own name together with the single word "JACK" in order for a clear record to be identified.
