# Focusing our attention on God

If we are finding it difficult to still our minds and focus on God's presence, then we can link a simple prayer to our natural rhythm of breathing in and out using a single syllable word such as 'God' or 'Love'. However, many people will find a longer invocation more suitable, such as a phrase from the psalms: "Be still and know that I am God", or "God, come to my aid; O, Lord, make haste to help me".

As we give our attention to God, it is not easy to know that God is giving His attention to us. But we don't need to get concerned about this. We can simply keep faithful to our desire to open ourselves to God and keep our attention on Him, knowing that God wants to relate to us. God is already holding us in His hands and gazing on us with love. The Benedictine monk, Cardinal Basil Hume once said that we do not get better at prayer with time, but our desire to pray gets stronger.

God is calling each of us to develop a unique and personal relationship, to become His friend. Having become more aware that we live in His presence, we can be more truly ourselves before Him - with all our hopes and fears, joys and

QUIET FRIDAY WORTH ABBEY 13th SEPTEMBER: Normally on the second Friday of each month there is a time for stillness and solitude and to enjoy the attractive grounds and Quiet Garden. For this reason, only a limited input is provided, and silence is encouraged.
